December 4, 2023 (E-127)	<p>Consolidation of a Measure with the Primary Election Last day to submit resolution requesting consolidation to the Board of Supervisors (BOS) to be calendared for the December 19, 2023, BOS meeting. Resolution to include: request for ROV to provide services, ballot question (75-word limit), passage requirements, Full Text, instruction to include or exclude Full Text printing in Voter Information Guide, Tax Rate Statement, if applicable and Fiscal Impact Report, if applicable. File resolution with the ROV and a copy to the BOS. EC 9140, 9160, 9222, 9280, 9313, 10002, 10403</p>
December 19, 2023 (E-112)	<p>Board of Supervisors Meeting Calendar date for BOS to approve consolidation.</p>
December 22, 2023 (E-109)	<p>Publication For Special District, School District and County Measures, the county elections official shall publish a notice that includes the election date, election location, ballot question, passage requirement, and argument and rebuttal deadlines. EC 9163</p> <p>For Municipal Measures, the city clerk shall publish a public notice including the election date, election location, ballot question, passage requirement, and argument and rebuttal deadlines. EC 9205</p> <p>For Municipal Measures, the city clerk shall publish a synopsis of the measure at least one time not later than one week before the election in a newspaper of general circulation in the city. EC 12111</p>
January 3, 2024 (E-97)	<p>Filing Deadline: Argument For and Argument Against (300 Word Limit) 10-Day Public Examination Period: January 4 – January 13 GC 57146; EC 9162, 9282, 9315</p>
January 15, 2024 (E-85)	<p>Filing Deadline: Rebuttal to Argument For and Argument Against (250 Word Limit) 10-Day Public Examination Period: January 16 – January 25 EC 9167, 9285, 9286, 9317</p>
January 15, 2024 (E-85)	<p>Filing Deadline: County Counsel / City Attorney Impartial Analysis (500 Word Limit) 10-Day Public Examination Period: January 16 – January 25 EC 9160, 9280, 9313, 9314, 9500</p>
April 9, 2024 (E)	<p>ELECTION DAY The county elections office is open from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. EC 1000, 14212</p>
