The notice shall contain the date of the election, polling hours, any offices to be filled and/or measures to be voted on, the qualifications required for each office, location where declaration of candidacy forms will be available, where the forms are to be filed and the deadline for filing these forms. <p>July 3 (E-123)</p>	<p>Specifications of the Election Order School boards shall deliver this document to the County Superintendent of Schools and the county elections official. ED Code 5322</p>
<p>July 6 – August 5 (E-120 to E-90)</p>	<p>County Notice of Election The county elections official shall publish a Notice of Election between these dates. The notice shall contain the date of the general district election, name of the offices for which candidates may file, state the qualifications required for each office, location where declaration of candidacy forms will be available, where the forms are to be filed and the deadline for filing these forms. EC 12112</p>
<p>July 12 (E-114)</p>	<p>Municipal Calling of Special Election to Fill Vacancy Last date for a city council to call a special election to fill a vacancy on the next regularly established election date, to be held not less than 114 days from the call of the election. If the election is not called by this date, the vacancy cannot go to election on this established election date. GC 36512 (b)</p>
<p>July 13 – August 7 5:00 p.m. (E-113 to E-88)</p>	<p>Candidate Nomination Period Candidates (including incumbents seeking re-election to the same office) must file nomination documents with the county elections official during this period. Optional Candidate Statements of Qualifications are due. EC 10220, 10510, 13307</p>
<p>July 31 (E-95)</p>	<p>FPPC Semi-Annual Campaign Statement Due For period covering 1/1/15 – 6/30/15. GC 84200, 84218</p>
<p>August 5 – November 2 (E-90 to E-1)</p>	<p>FPPC Late Contributions and Independent Expenditures of \$1000 or More Within 24 hours of the transaction, FPPC Form 462, Form 496 or Form 497 must be filed with the appropriate filing officer GC 82036, 82036.5, 84200.6</p>
<p>August 7 5:00 p.m. (E-88)</p>	<p>Close of Candidate Nomination Period Candidate nomination documents are due. Incumbents who wish to file as a candidate for their own office must file by this date. Last day to withdraw declaration of candidacy papers except when there is an extension to that office. FPPC Statements of Economic Interest Form 700 are due. EC 8020, 10407; GC 87201</p>
<p>August 8 – August 12 5:00 p.m. (E-87 to E-83)</p>	<p>Extension of Candidate Nomination Period Extension period for candidates other than the incumbent if the incumbent did not file by E-88. This provision does not apply if there is no incumbent to be re-elected. EC 10225, 10407, 10516, 10604</p>

August 13 11:00 a.m. (E-82)	Randomized Alphabet Drawing Conducted by the Secretary of State to determine candidate name order as it will appear on the ballot. <i>EC 13112</i>
August 13 – August 23 (E-82 to E-72)	10-Day Public Examination Period For Statement of Qualifications During this period any voter of the jurisdiction or the county elections official may seek a writ of mandate or an injunction requiring any or all of the materials to be amended or deleted. The writ of mandate or injunction must be filed no later than the end of this period. <i>EC 13313</i>
September 4 (E-60)	Special Vote By Mail Ballot Requests First day the county elections official may process applications for special Vote by Mail ballot requests (Military and Overseas voters). <i>EC 300, 3103</i>
September 24 – October 13 (E-40 to E-21)	Sample Ballot Pamphlets Pamphlets are mailed to each registered voter during this time. <i>EC 13303</i>
September 24 (E-40)	1st FPPC Pre-Election Campaign Statement Due For the period covering 7/1/15 – 9/19/15. <i>GC 84200.7(b)(1)</i>
October 5 – October 27 (E-29 to E-7)	Regular Vote by Mail Ballot Mailing and processing period for Vote by Mail ballots. Ballots will be available at the county elections office. <i>EC 15101</i>
October 19 (E-15)	15-Day Close Last day to register for this election. Postmarks, DMV and personal delivery to the elections office are acceptable. <i>EC 2107</i>
October 22 (E-12)	2nd FPPC Pre-Election Campaign Statement Due For the period covering 9/20/15 – 10/17/15. <i>GC 84200.7(b)(2)</i>
October 27 (E-7)	Municipal Publication Not later than one week before the election, the city clerk shall publish a list of the nominees and the respective offices for which they have been nominated. If applicable, this publication shall also include a synopsis of any measure that will appear on the ballot. <i>EC 12110, 12111</i>
October 28 – November 3 (E-6 to E)	Special 7-Day Ballots Available Available at the county elections office for those voters unable to vote at the polls on Election Day. <i>EC 3021</i>
November 3 (E)	ELECTION DAY Polls are open from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. <i>EC 1000, 14212</i>
November 5 –November 23 (E+2 to E+20)	Canvass of the Vote Official canvass of precinct returns shall commence and be completed during this period. The ROV shall prepare a certified statement of the results and submit it to the governing bodies involved with this election. <i>EC 15301, 15372</i>
December 4	Elected and Appointed District Officials Will Take Office At noon on the first Friday in December following this election. <i>EC 10554</i>
February 1, 2016	FPPC Semi-Annual Campaign Statement Due For period covering 10/18/15 – 12/31/15 (if required to file pre-election statements) For period covering 7/1/15 – 12/31/15 (if not required to file pre-election statements) <i>GC 84200, 84218</i>

<p>July 3, 2015 (E-123)</p>	<p>Consolidation of a Measure with the General District Election (UDEL) Last day to submit a Resolution requesting consolidation to Board of Supervisors to be calendared for the July 14, 2015 BOS meeting. Resolution to include: request for ROV to provide services, ballot question (75 word limit), passage requirements, full text (including Tax Rate Statement and Fiscal Impact Report, if applicable), and Impartial Analysis (if already prepared). Such request shall be made to the Board of Supervisors and a copy of the request to the ROV. <i>EC 9140, 9160, 9222, 9280, 9313, 10002, 10403</i></p>
<p>July 6, 2015 (E-120)</p>	<p>Publication For Special District, School District and County Measures, the county elections official shall publish a notice that includes the election date, election location, ballot question, passage requirement and argument and rebuttal deadlines. <i>EC 9163</i></p> <p>For Municipal Measures, the city clerk will publish this notice for measures that are consolidated with the UDEL election.</p> <p>For Municipal Measures, the city clerk shall publish a synopsis of the measure at least one time not later than one week before the election in a newspaper of general circulation in the city. <i>EC 12111</i></p>
<p>July 14, 2015</p>	<p>Board of Supervisors Meeting Calendar date for BOS to approve consolidation.</p>
<p>July 17, 2015 (E-109)</p>	<p>Deadline: Arguments For and Against <i>GC 57146; EC 9162, 9282, 9315</i></p>
<p>July 27, 2015 (E-99)</p>	<p>Deadline: Rebuttals to Arguments For and Against <i>EC 9167, 9285, 9286, 9317</i></p>
<p>July 28, 2015 – August 7, 2015 (E-98 to E-88)</p>	<p>10-Day Public Examination Period <i>EC 9190, 9380, 9286, 9295</i></p>
